ORGANIZATIONAL OVERVIEW:

Willowbrook provides opportunities for children to develop their creative potential through experiences in the arts and nature in an atmosphere that mentors and nurtures the whole child, promotes a spirit of peaceful collaboration, and encourages individual exploration and expression. PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Willowbrook will offer in-person and virtual classes that are uniquely Willowbrook, with an emphasis on interactive, student driven programs that allow for some choice and focus on the experience rather than the outcome. We will work with our community partner, the City of Tualatin Parks and Recreation Department, to maximize visibility and fill community needs.
Classes will have a visual arts focus.

DETAILS:

Willowbrook is looking for experienced art educators who understand how to make in-person and online programming interactive. Classes will be 90 minutes and meet weekly for six weeks in a local City of Tualatin park and may transition to virtual programming in December.

Hybrid programming can be offered; the in-person portion of these classes will take place in sheltered areas of Tualatin public parks (this will be pending state guidelines for COVID-19 when the class is offered).

The focus will be on ages 5 through 14, and multiage classes are preferred. Bilingual instruction ability is preferred, but not required.

DELIVERABLES:

- 90-minutes of planned, prepared and delivered visual arts instruction for six weeks designed for ages 5-14
- List of supplies with deadlines needed for program delivery

TIMELINE:

Willowbrook plans to begin offering in-person and virtual arts and nature classes in mid-October. We will continue to offer new classes in 2021-22. Please apply immediately. We are hoping to start classes in mid October. Applications will also be considered for future program dates in 2022.
